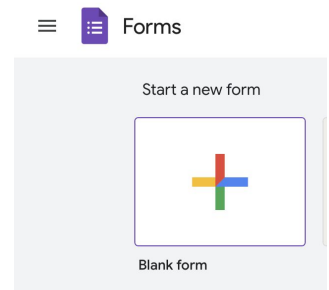
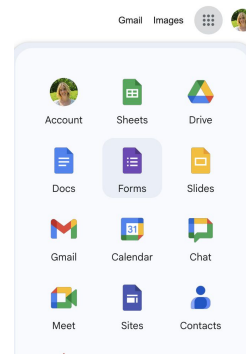
80% of viewers will understand how to create Google Forms to track their data.

Activities: Demo making a template form. I will use viewer data from earlier in the presentation to fill in my template and make it more individualized

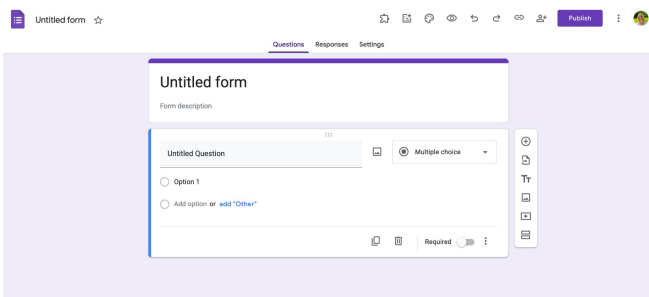
Materials: Computer, projector, engaged audience

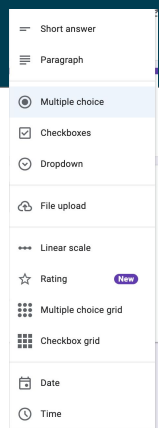

Should I make a question required - Do I track every goal, every session ?

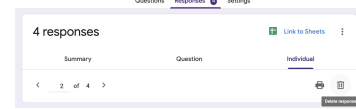
After I create the form, how do I see what responders will see? - Preview mode

How can I check if I like the way a question collects data - fill out the form multiple times and see the Responses

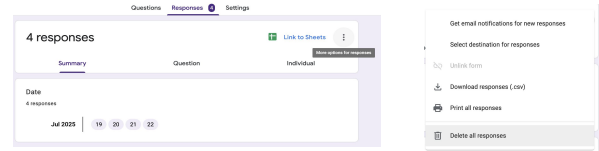

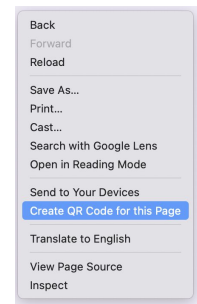

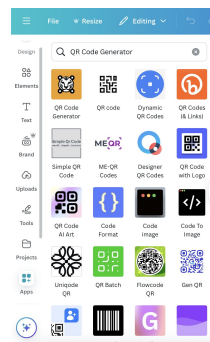
How to make QR Codes

Google Chrome: Right-click any webpage → “Create QR Code.”

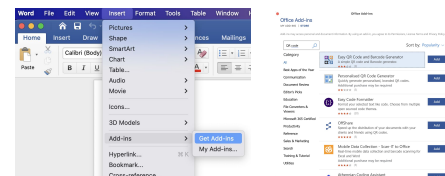


How to make QR Codes

Canva / Adobe Express: Design platforms often have built-in QR generators for branded marketing materials.



Microsoft Office: Word/Excel/PowerPoint add-ins can generate QR codes directly inside documents.

Case Study

Scenario: Dana is 6th grader in a mainstream setting whom you see twice a week for 30 min. She uses bilateral hearing aids that connect to a DM microphone at school. She has a self-advocacy goal related to her hearing assistive technology across school settings.

Barriers: Inconsistently bringing the hearing aids to school. Selective refusal to use DM system - usually when listening to audio from chromebook, Inconsistent access to batteries

Case Study

Scenario : Dana is a new preschooler transitioning from First Steps. She uses bilateral cochlear implants, but has not bonded as strongly to her Right CI as she has the left. Teachers do an LMH 10 sounds check every morning and want an easy way to track online rather than using paper pencil
